PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The CHC30113 Certificate III in Early Childhood Education and Care is designed for students who want to:

- Learn to work in a range of early childhood education settings, including preschools, family day care, long day care or out-of-school hours care centres.
- Gain experience and knowledge in supporting children's wellbeing, learning and development
- Become a nanny, family day educator or operate a child minding service in a recreation centre or gym

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no formal entry requirements or pre-requisites for this qualification.

However, a Pre-Training Review will be undertaken with each learner prior to enrolment to determine if the program is suitable and appropriate.

SPECIAL REQUIREMENTS

A current Police Check and Working with Children Check will be required to undertake work placement.

DELIVERY

This course is full time, delivered over 36 weeks (9 months) including holidays. This comprises:

- 4 days per week (Scheduled Classes and Work Placement)
- Approx. 5 hours per week (homework/self-study)
- 160 hours work placement

There are no scheduled activities during the holidays.

Potential career outcomes include:

- Family Day Care Educator
- Mobile Service Educator
- Occasional Care Educator
- Play Group Supervisor
- Nanny
- Outside School Hours Care Assistant *
- Recreation Assistant *

* Some jurisdictions may require CHC40113 Certificate IV in School age education and care for these work roles.

This qualification also provides pathways to a series of Certificate IV and Diploma level qualifications.
