Provide an emergency first aid response in an education and care setting



This course provides the skills and knowledge required to provide a first aid response to infants, children and adults.

It applies to educators and support staff working within an education and care setting who are required to respond to a first aid emergency, including asthmatic and anaphylactic emergencies.

It also has broader application for anyone responsible for applying first aid procedures at home or in the workplace.

The Australian Resuscitation Council recommends that all those trained in CPR should refresh their CPR skills at least annually.
