Whilst his licence was under review, he had a car accident and was charged by police with driving whilst suspended and dangerous driving.

Fortunately for John*, a social worker from an aged care facility brought him to Brimbank Melton Community Legal Centre (BMCLC).

A solicitor from BMCLC gathered medical material for the client and made a submission to police prosecution. As a result, the charges were withdrawn and John* did not have to go to court.
