ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

There are no entry requirements or pre-requisites for this qualification. Students are enrolled in a qualification at the level appropriate to their needs and skills.

DELIVERY

This course is delivered across 26 weeks including school holidays.

The 26 weeks' studying duration include:

- 6 hours per week, 14 weeks' face-to-face delivery in classroom
- 6 hours structured self-learning activities per week
- 40 hours (5 hours per week for 8 weeks) supervised practical placement
